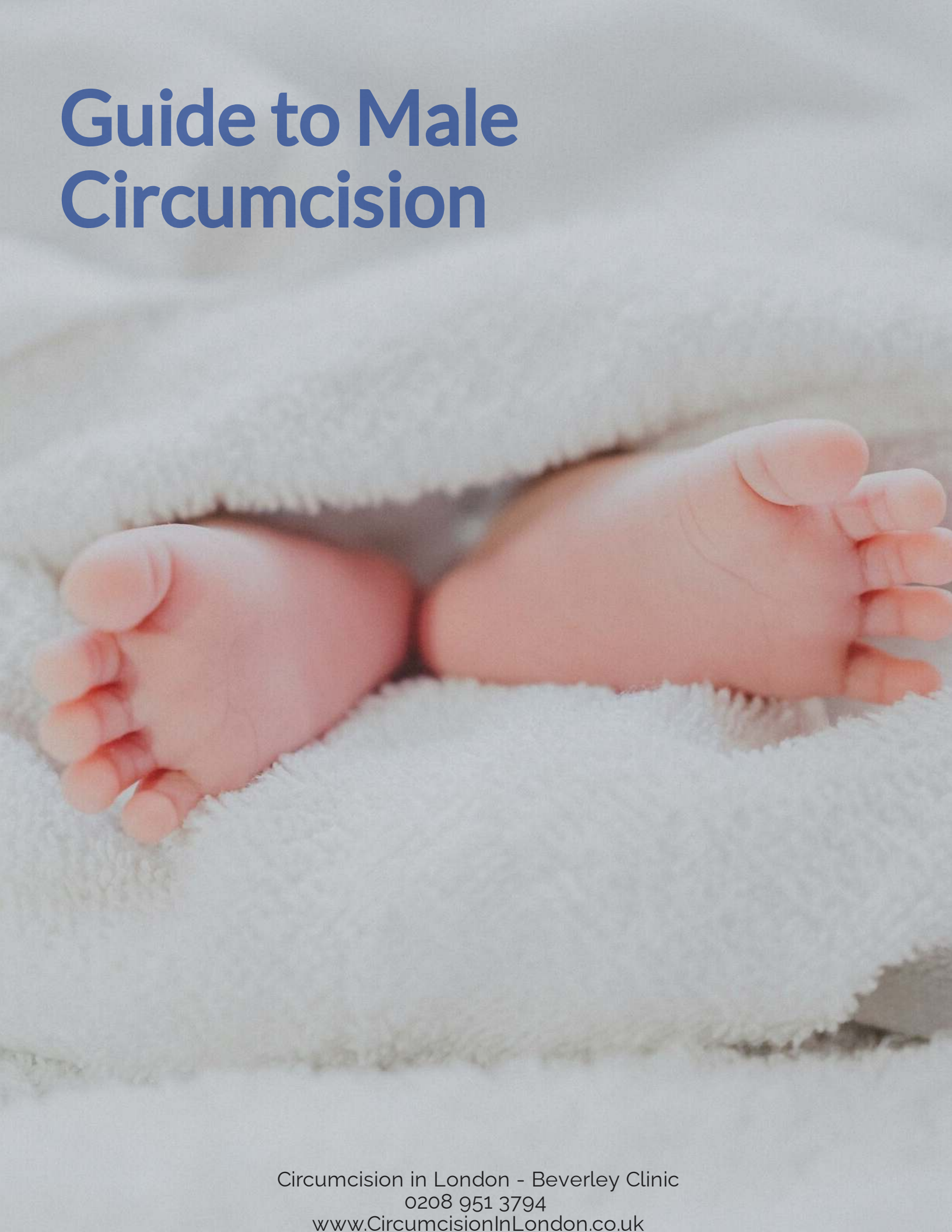

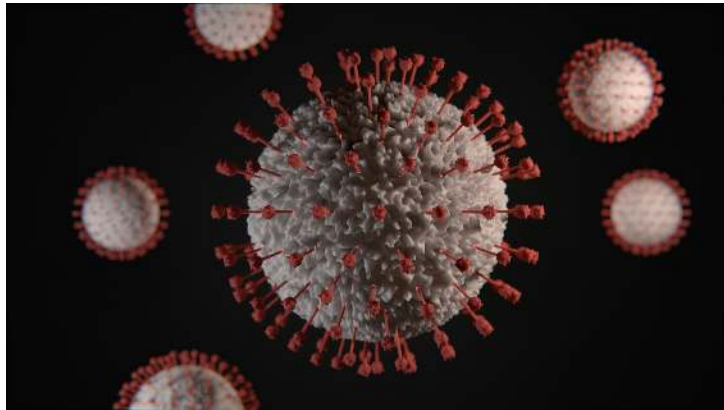


Benefits of Male Circumcision

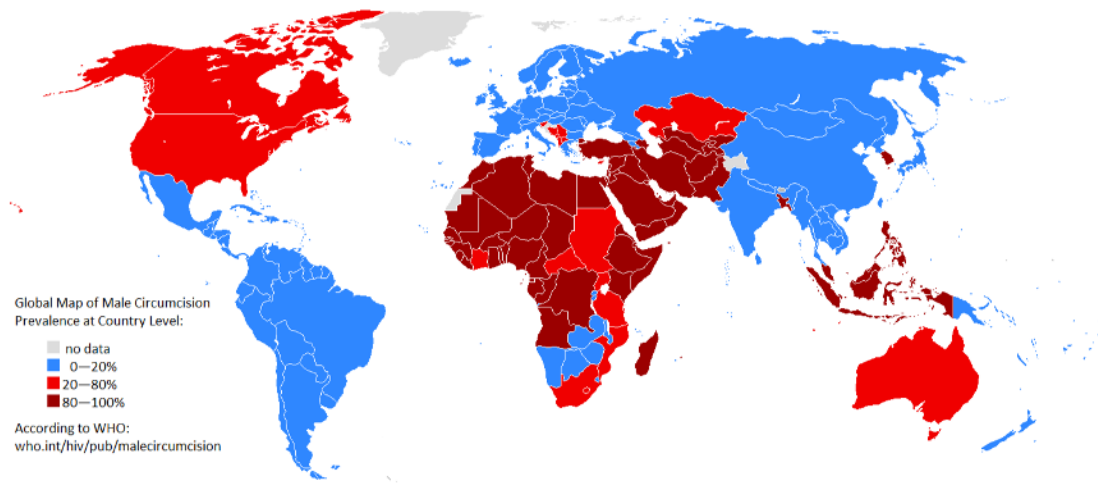

Common reasons for circumcision

Religious requirements- Islam and Judaism.

Cultural and hygiene reasons - parts of Africa, Asia, Philippines, USA, Canada, Australia, South Africa.

Medical reasons - tight foreskin (phimosis), inflammation of the head of the penis (balanitis), Recurrent infections and pain.

What is the best age for circumcision?

We serve all ages and have treated countless patients from a few days old to adults in their 80s. But if you had a choice, we always recommend to do the circumcision at an early age and preferably under 1 month old.

The Best Circumcision Methods:

Ring method (Plastibell and Circumplast)

This is usually used for babies and toddlers under 3 years old. It is similar to the umbilical cord where the foreskin is tied off and becomes dead skin and falls off after a couple of days. The advantages are that it is often a quick procedure without the need for any stitching. The nappy can also be applied straight away and the patient bathed as well. The disadvantage is that sometimes the swelling can stop the ring from coming off and you will need a quick follow up appointment for us to remove it. This usually takes a few seconds to remove and most of the time, the ring will come off naturally by itself.

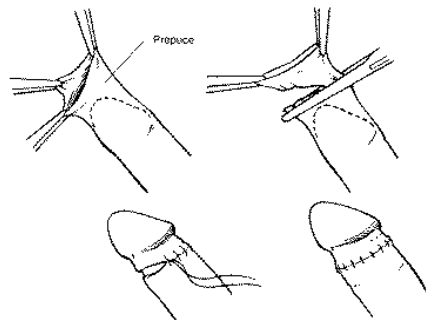

The Best Circumcision Methods:

Forceps guided method (traditional method):

This is usually used for babies and toddlers under 3 years old. It is similar to the umbilical cord where the foreskin is tied off and becomes dead skin and falls off after a couple of days. The advantages are that it is often a quick procedure without the need for any stitching. The nappy can also be applied straight away and the patient bathed as well. The disadvantage is that sometimes the swelling can stop the ring from coming off and you will need a quick follow up appointment for us to remove it. This usually takes a few seconds to remove and most of the time, the ring will come off naturally by itself.

Both methods give very similar end results and the surgeon will decide which method is best to use for the patient.

Is it painful?

The circumcision is done under local anaesthetic which means the patient is awake but the penis will be numb. This is done via a very small injection similar to vaccinations. Topical local anaesthetic creams alone are not effective as the patient will still feel pain during the surgery. They are also ineffective before the injection as they only numb the skin superficially and do not provide any pain relief when the local anaesthetic injection is administered as it usually stings for a few seconds before making the area numb. The local anaesthetic works very quickly within 1 minute and we test the patient before starting the surgery to make sure he is not feeling pain.



Took my son for his circumcision and I must say I was impressed by how professional and helpful the staffs were. Got messages to remind me of my appointment, the whole procedure made look easy and my son felt no pain. I received follow up calls after the procedure to check how my son is doing; the clinic itself was so clean and tidy. How long does it take?

The surgery is usually 5-10 mins for babies and toddlers once the LA is given. For older children and adults, it can take 20-40 minutes depending on the size and complexity of the penis.



We took our 3 week son here. We were initially worried about the procedure but upon arrival, the receptionist was great and really settled our nerves. Dr Haider was very professional and explained each step very clearly and the procedure itself was not as bad as feared, as our little one didn't cry as much as we thought he would. The procedure also did not take too long.

Will there be pain after the surgery?

This depends on the patient and their pain threshold. Most patients report being absolutely fine or minimal discomfort. Some patients with a low pain threshold report pain during the healing period. This is normal after surgery and is usually well managed with Paracetamol (2 months and older). Babies under 2 months are not advised as Calpol is licenced for 2 months and older only. We have not had issues because of this as this age usually has the ring method where the foreskin is dead similar to the umbilical cord and does not have any more sensation but the baby may not like the sensation of the ring and will be unsettled initially until he gets used to the sensation and calm down in his own time.



I was recommended to Beverly clinic by extended family member that had a positive experience and I'm so glad I also bought my 3 weeks old son here. The instructions prior to the procedure was very clear and helpful, they provided me with links to video and pictures of the procedure and after care; which was very helpful. The receptionist was lovely, reassuring and very welcoming. Dr Haider was also very reassuring and went through the procedure prior to starting, my baby was very calm and in no pain at all, healing process was very quick and the ring fell off in 5 days.

Aftercare

We provide you with in depth videos to watch when you book an appointment that explains what to expect on the day of the circumcision and the aftercare as well. We also provide you with written aftercare instructions advise sheet and explain it to you verbally. You will also have our videos to refer back to and we are always available to help with either phone calls, WhatsApp messages or by email. We usually reply within a few minutes during our opening hours. Incase of continuous bleeding emergencies, we do have a 24/7 phone number for our patients also. Home or clinic visits?

How to choose a clinic?
